Description of Sessions

Baby Massage **2-8 MTHS**

Baby Massage is run over 5 weeks by IAIM qualified instructors. You will learn to massage your baby using approved strokes and techniques about the benefits of massage.

Breastfeeding Social

This service is run by volunteers trained by the Breastfeeding Network. Come along and receive one to one support, advice and guidance whilst meeting other new mums. There is also book borrowing service on offer.

Bumps and Babies **0-18 MTHS**

An opportunity for mums to be and parents/carers of children under 18 months to meet up on a weekly basis in a safe and stimulating environment. Children's Centre staff are available throughout the session to offer support and advice if needed. The session ends with a fun singing session and free refreshments in our Starjumps Café.

Child Health Clinics **0-5 YRS**

Baby clinic is run by the local Health Visitor team. It is an opportunity for you to receive support and advice on a wide range of family health issues

Children's Centre Information Point **0-5 YRS**

Why not pop along to find out more information about the Children's Centre, or to gain some advice on other local services.

Creative Play **2-5 YRS**

A drop in session for you and your child to come along to and enjoy a range of messy play activities. Children's Centre staff will plan different activities each week which will help in developing your child's creativity and enable them to experience different shapes, textures, colours and scents. Please dress your children in suitable clothing for messy play.

Events – Teddy Bears Picnic in the Park **0-5 YRS** with SureStart Bear.

Bring your favourite Teddy Bear and a picnic to the Phillimore Recreation Ground. Children's Centre will be providing fun and games, free Face Painting. The SureStart Bear will be there to join in the fun.

Family Fun Day/Picnic **0-5 YRS**

Come along and enjoy the summer with your children. There will be lots of activities for parents/carers to share with your children. Why not bring along a picnic to have with your children.

Fun for Under 1's **0-1 YR**

This session is for children under 1 year and their parents/carers. Children will be given the opportunity to explore and play with lots of different equipment and resources in a safe and stimulating environment.

Fun in the Park **0-5 YRS**

Get active and have fun at our outside sessions. Sand and water play, bubble chasing, team games and a good run around. All activities are with parents/carer interaction. These sessions are designed by children's centre staff to help parents and carers with new ideas on how to use the park and surrounding areas.

Funky Monkey Movers (formerly Sticky Kids) **18MTHS-5YRS**

Help develop your child's physical development and listening skills through this fun and lively music

Music and Movement **2-5 YRS**

An energetic and fun activity for parents/carers and their children aimed at developing physical skills. Each session will finish with a different focus activity including Sticky Kids, singing and parachute games.

Parachute Games **2-5 YRS**

Why not pop down to the park and enjoy parachute games. We will be doing all sorts of different activities with the parachute from singing to putting colourful balls into it. This is a really enjoyable session that the children will love!

Post Natal Group **0-6 MTHS**

This is a 4 week rolling programme for mum's and their new babies. Children Centre staff will be working closely with local Health Visitors to provide information and support on a wide range of relevant topics, for further details please contact your local Children's Centre.

Play and Stay **0-5 YRS**

A fun filled session which brings together all your children's favorite activities. We will cover the six areas of learning and development (creative, physical, personal social and emotional, communication language and literacy, problem solving reasoning numeracy, knowledge and understanding of the world) this is a great opportunity for you and your child to make friends with families in your local community.

Singing and Stories **0-5 YRS**

A relaxed session for children and their parents/carers. This session aims to encourage young children to listen and join in with rhymes and songs, whilst exploring instruments and the sounds they make. We will also be reading stories, this is a great session to get your child interested and excited about stories and books.

Sticky Kids **2-5 YRS**

Help develop your child's listening skills through this interactive fun and lively music session. For children aged 2 – 5 years.

Stories and More **0-5 YRS**

Come along and take part in an interactive story session with your child. Following the story the children will have the opportunity to join in activities that link to the story. Sharing stories is a great way to improve children's early literacy skills.
